

Through the SCP program, approved businesses will receive a 50% match on a surveillance camera system. The business partner will pay \$1200.00 and Safe & Sound will pay \$1200.00. The surveillance camera system publicly retails for \$3000.00.

That includes:

- 3 HD resolution bullet cameras
- 1 LCD 18.5 inch monitor
- 3 Hours of installation

## What is the SCP?

Safe & Sound, Milwaukee Police Department and the city of Milwaukee have partnered together to bring affordable surveillance camera equipment to local businesses in MPD districts 2, 3, 5 and 7. Together, we can make the community a safer place for your business and the residents of the neighborhood.

The camera feed is transmitted through your standard internet connection. It is required that you have at least a 4 megabits per second upload speed. Applicant will pay any costs associated with the transmission of the camera feed to MPD.

Applicant agrees that the live feed can and will be monitored by MPD.

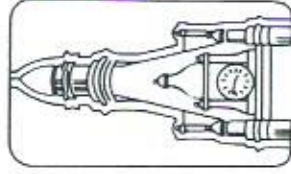
Applicant is responsible for notifying Cornerstone Security Group if there is a change in internet service or provider.

All video recordings shall be stored and maintained for 10 business days.

MPD recordings may be retained beyond 10 business days when the recording contains evidence of criminal activity.

The following types of property are **NOT** eligible for this Program:

- Tax delinquent property
- Property whose owner has any other tax delinquent property
- Property in litigation
- Property in condemnation or receivership
- Exclusively residential buildings

## Surveillance Camera Program Guidelines

- Applicant agrees to pay 50% of cost and expense to purchase, install, and maintain cameras.
- The video camera system is to be installed as a matter of public safety. Its primary use will be for conducting law enforcement investigations and in deterring crime.
- Applicant will pay any and all costs associated with the transmission of the camera feed to the MPD monitoring station, including any wireless, telephone or similar transmission costs.
- Applicant agrees that the live feed will be monitored by MPD at such hours and with such staffing levels as the department shall determine appropriate.
- If the applicant is terminated from participation or voluntarily withdraws, the applicant is responsible for the cost and expense of removal of monitor and cameras.
- Applicant is responsible for notifying Cornerstone Security Group if there is a change in internet service provider.
- All video recordings shall be stored and maintained for 10 business days after which time they will be recorded over or destroyed.
- MPD recordings may be retained beyond 10 business days when the recording contains evidence of criminal activity.

### The following types of property are not eligible for this grant Program:

- Tax delinquent property
- Property whose owner has any other tax delinquent property
- Property in litigation
- Property in condemnation or receivership
- Exclusively residential buildings
