## Youthpower Comes to Metcalfe Park and 30th Street Corridor

Elmer Winter, co-founder and past President of Manpower, announced the reopening of Youthpower to provide summer jobs to the youth living in the Metcalfe Park area.

According to Winter, "It is imperative that we provide a free job placement service to the hundreds of young men and women (ages 16 - 22) who live in Metcalfe Park, an area with excessively high unemployment and a high rate of crime. We need to show the youth living in the area the opportunities available in the world of work and give them a chance to have a job and be financially

independent."

The Youthpower Employment Center is located in the Fitzsimonds Boys & Girls Club located at 3400 W. North Avenue. Edna Mathews is onsite as Director of Youthpower to interview, assessed and place area youth into jobs. With experience as a school principal, businesswoman and non-profit coordinator, Edna is well equipped for this role. Winter urges Milwaukee area companies to contact Youthpower at 414-874-3735 to learn more about hiring job candidates through the program.

Working with Youthpower, Winter pointed out, will eliminate the need for employers to evaluate a large number of applications, since Youthpower will make an employment assessment without charge.

Youthpower also provides soft skills training to acquaint applicants with employer requirements. Winter noted that while he served as President of Manpower in the 1960s, the company operated Youthpower in 10 cities.

In the four years in which Youthpower operated, its volunteers placed over 10,000 young men and women in summer jobs. Winter stated that Youthpower will cooperate with Mayor Barrett in response to his urgent call for Milwaukee citizens to recognize the need to provide summer jobs for Milwaukee youth.

It is the thrust of Youthpower that "no job shall be left unfilled". Winter asks that we give our youth a chance to be challenged and awarded through a work experience.
